

Claim for Capital Credits
Following Member Bankruptcy

For distribution to Members or Former Members

If you are a member or former member and believe that you are entitled to payment of capital credits from Rio Grande Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("RGEC") that were not paid to you and you filed bankruptcy, you must complete a Capital Credits Claim Form which is available online at RGEC's website.

You must provide the following information in order for RGEC to evaluate your claim:

1. Proof of the Date that Bankruptcy was filed by you.
2. Copy of full Bankruptcy Petition and Schedules including:
 - a. Schedule A through J; and
 - b. Statement of Financial Affairs
3. Copy of Debtor's Discharge for a Chapter 7 or Chapter 13 case, or in a Chapter 11 or Chapter 12 case, a copy of The Plan of Reorganization and Order Approving/Confirming said Plan of Reorganization.
4. Additional information may be required initially or after review of documents that are initially submitted.

If you do not have copies of these documents, you should be able to obtain copies of them from the bankruptcy court or from the attorney who handled your bankruptcy.
